How can I

encourage others

to use their gifts?

CONNECTING POINT

In this Sunday's second reading, St. Paul encourages us to live in the Spirit as members of the Body of Christ using the gifts that the Spirit gives each of us. Then in the gospel, we see Jesus putting his gifts to work at the Wedding at Cana. However, Jesus didn't put his gifts to use out of his own initiative; his mother had to encourage him to put his gifts into action.

When I was twelve, my mom encouraged me to audition for a musical. I had no interest in doing this on my own, but with her encouragement, I reluctantly auditioned. It is because of this

encouragement that I am now using my musical gifts as a career to serve our community and beyond.

Sometimes I think we try to avoid thinking about what our gifts are and how we could be using them. Why? Because if we realize what these gifts are and that we're not using them, we might feel guilty (and nobody likes to feel guilty). So... we just avoid thinking about them.

The fact is that we all have gifts that can and should be put into action. A great way

to put those gifts into action is right here at St. Isidore in liturgical ministries.

I'm going to be brutally honest and say that our liturgical ministries at St. Isidore are extremely depleted right now. We are desperate for help and practically begging active volunteers each week to cover Masses in the ministries of lector, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, altar server, and AV ministry (not to mention ushers, greeters, funeral ministers, and singers in our choir). We just don't have enough volunteers despite more than 1300

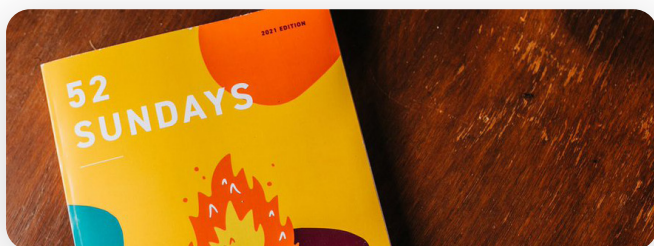

WEDDING FEAST AT CANA

DID YOU KNOW?

Turning the water into wine at the Cana wedding was recorded as the first miracle of Jesus. The Bible tells us that after they saw Jesus perform this miracle, the disciples believed in him. That was always the reason that Jesus performed a miracle. He didn't do it so that he would become popular or well-liked. He did it so that all would believe that he was God's Son who had come to save them.

PRAISE

Throughout scripture, God is very insistent about praise. I suspect we have much to learn about the amazing, mysterious power of this humble activity. Praise makes room in our hearts for God's will to be done, and recognizes the absurdity of any attempt to manipulate God in prayer. He is sovereign. This awesome Creator, who loves us so much that He sent Jesus to die for us that we might have a place in His family, deserves our adoration and praise.

The very "sacrifice" of praise - working at it when we don't feel like it - draws us into the presence of the Lord. People of praise discover that this action of the heart, the mind (and sometimes just the will) is very healthy for the body, mind, and spirit. Praise draws us into a healthy mental attitude. Praise increases our capacity to live and grow in love and holiness. Let us praise God in all things! (Miracle Hour)

A Wedding at Cana

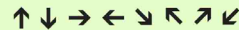
