## ▶ CSA 2023

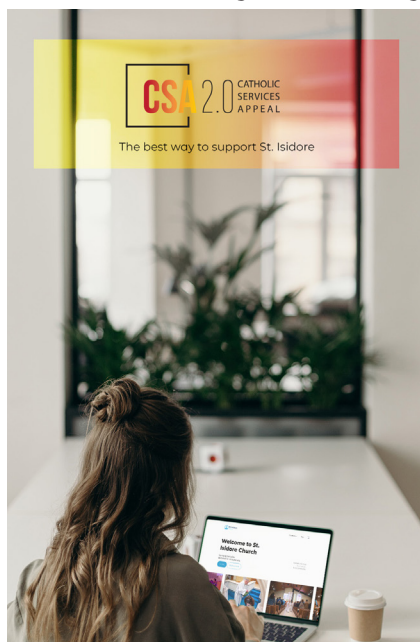

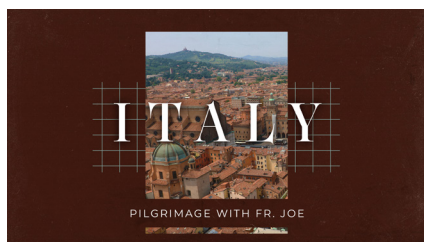

The exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is offered every Tuesday at St. Isidore in the Resource Center immediately following 8:00 AM Mass and concludes with Benediction at 4:15 PM. The Resource Center is located the first door to the right as you enter the Church from the Mary's Garden Entrance on the Romeo Plank side of the Church.

We are in need of additional regular weekly coverage for the hours of 12:30-1:30 and 2:30-3:30. We also

need additional people who can serve as an occasional substitute. If participating in this personal and private time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament is of interest to you, please let us know.

There is no formality to private Eucharistic Adoration. Pray the Rosary or your favorite prayers, read scripture, talk to the Lord and share your burdens or your joys, or just sit in His presence and let Him speak to you in the silence.

If you cannot commit to one hour each week or being an occasional substitute, please feel free to stop in anytime during the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesdays; spend as little or as much time as you need with our Lord.

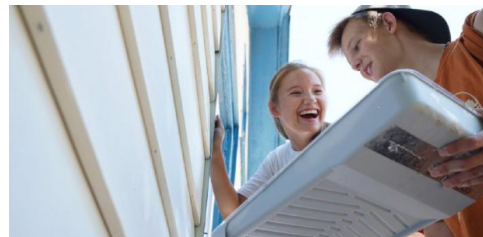

We are out of or have a very low supply of many necessary baby/toddler items. The need is great. If possible, please donate from this list for local families:

- Diaper rash ointment with NO zinc (We have none.)
- Puffs (We have none.)
- Aveeno baby lotion (We have none.)
- Baby shampoo (We have none.)
- Baby cereal - oatmeal (We are very low.)
- Baby lotion (We have low stock.)
- Baby wash (We have hardly any.)
- Sensitive, fragrance-free wipes (We are running low.)
- Puffs (We are out of them.)
