The Gospel seems clear; Jesus wants us to come to him with our burdens. However, I have found in my life that often times is easier said than done. Especially growing up in a culture that promotes independence and self-reliance as cardinal goods. As a young man, I bought into the myth that sharing what was burdening me merely

showed weakness and an inability to get along. I put on a show of being successful and happy, but inside I was pretty empty and miserable.

It wasn't until my late 20's, when I began meeting with a small group of faith companions after attending a Cursillo retreat weekend, that I

began to learn that sharing your weaknesses and burdens is the only way to truly get along. The men I shared with each Saturday, constantly helped me to lean more and more on Jesus in times of struggle, and to recognize His help in every success. From that time until today, meeting on a regular basis with faith companions, has

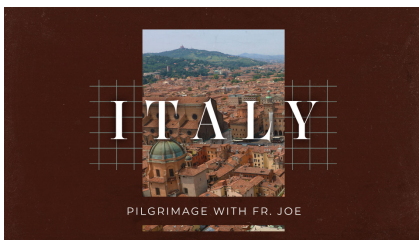

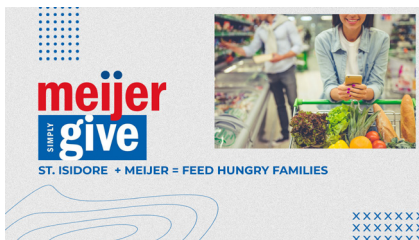
Over the decades, the faith sharing

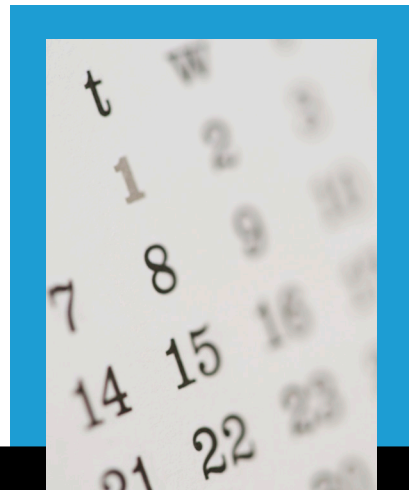
Almighty Father, I place the Precious Blood of Jesus before my lips before I pray, that my prayers may be purified before they ascend to Your divine altar.

Did You Know? July

July, seventh month of the Gregorian calendar. It was named after Julius Caesar in 44 A.D. Its original name Quintilis, Latin for the "fifth month," indicating its position in the early Roman calendar. In the Catholic Church this month is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted

in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood. (allakes.org)
