with others.

To recall the words from the Prayer of St. Francis: In the very act of giving, we receive. This month, ask, "What can I give in service to others so that I may receive blessings from God?"

One thing we can do is engage in Corporal Works of Mercy: praying for the dead or visiting cemeteries, visiting the sick and imprisoned, donating food to the parish food pantry, delivering meals on wheels, or

simply helping a neighbor with some chores around the house. Another way is to participate in parish or civic initiatives such as the Giving Tree, rummage sales, charitable auctions, and the like. In our Family of Parishes, we are sponsoring Kids Coalition Against Hunger, which aims to feed 100,000 people at 35 cents per meal. While most volunteer opportunities are full, we also need your financial support. Our target is \$35,000. As you give thanks for your blessings, in your prayer this week, ask the Lord how you can give back to others by engaging in humble service. What kind of endeavors is God inviting you to participate in this month to live out your Catholic-Christian commitment?

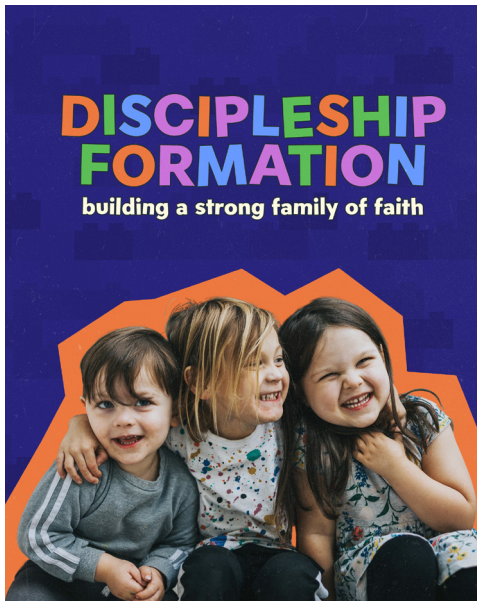

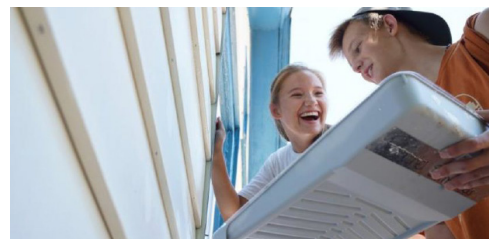
The virtue of humility is sometimes hard. Try to practice some humility this week. Let others go before you, when possible, and try not to boast.

Did You Know?

Isn't God present everywhere? How is the Eucharist different?

God is present to his people in many ways. In the most foundational way, God is omnipresent - present everywhere - by virtue of his power in holding everything in existence. Life would cease to exist if God did not keep it in existence moment by moment by his power.

But God is even closer to us in profound spiritual ways. Christ is present in a special way in the poor, in his Word, in the sacraments, and in the prayer of

two or more gathered in his name.

Even more, however, Jesus is uniquely present in the Eucharist. For the Eucharist is the very Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Through the Eucharist, "Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly and entirely present." Therefore, when we encounter the Eucharist, we encounter the same Jesus who walked the streets of Galilee two thousand years ago, made present to us now under the sacramental signs of bread and wine.
