## ▶ Connecting Point (cont'd)

The Gospel this weekend ultimately challenges us to be ready to meet the Lord when he comes again. In the Gospel, Jesus shares a parable about ten virgins who take their lamps and go out to meet the bridegroom. Half of them are prepared with oil for their lamps, and half are not. When the bridegroom arrives, only the prepared virgins are welcomed into the feast. We must be prepared for him, as well.

To me, being spiritually prepared is consistently following God's greatest commands: to love him and others. This means putting others first and being kind, thankful, and humble. God doesn't expect us to be perfect in this, but that's okay. As St. Paul reminds us, amid our imperfections and weaknesses, the Lord is present to strengthen and forgive us. He sustains us, leads us through dark valleys, and welcomes us into his wedding banquet with open arms to

all. If we live our lives prepared and conscious of these commands, we'll be ready whenever he comes.

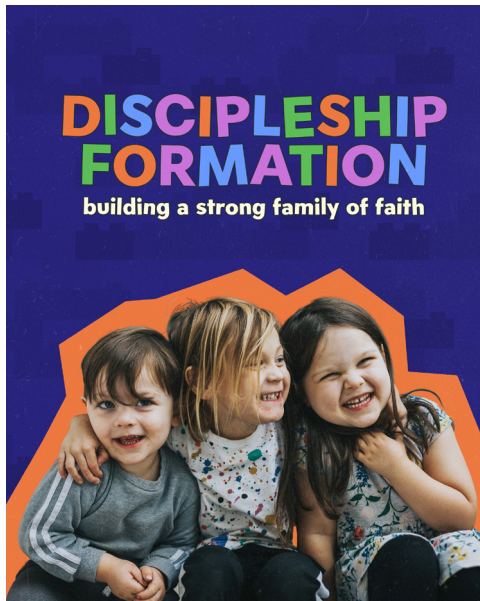
