CHOSEN
PEOPLE?

Throughout the scriptures, God chooses people to be his own (Noah, Abraham, and David, to name a few), as well as nations (the people of Israel, for example). Later, Jesus, through the disciples, chooses people to be members of His Body. Today, God still chooses people; we are God's chosen ones.

When we audition for a band or try

out for a team, we may or may not be chosen. If we are, we must perform to a certain expectation; otherwise, we will be cut from the roster. By our baptism and confirmation (indeed, even by birth), God has chosen and invited us to be one with him. But, how do we respond to this choice? While we do not try out to be on "God's team," there is a certain expectation that we live up to our

calling as team members. We could reject God outright, in which case we risk being "cut from the team" and condemning ourselves to eternal punishment, but very few people actually do that. Most of us genuinely want to do well and be good human beings.

But as Christians, we know God has chosen us for a purpose. We are

Having completed the Easter Season we have now entered into Ordinary Time in the church. The word "ordinary" comes from the word "ordinal," which means a number. We call this Ordinary Time because the weeks are numbered. (Tomorrow we will begin the "Eighth Week of Ordinary Time.") In other words, Ordinary Time is not the opposite of extraordinary time! Every Season of the Liturgical Year is extraordinary and has its own importance! Let us enter fully into this season.

When people ask me when we celebrate the Sacrament of

Reconciliation at St. Isidore, I point out that the sacrament is celebrated at 3:15 on Saturday afternoon. But I then encouraged them to make an appointment with me to celebrate the Sacrament. In that way we can take time to more fully celebrate the sacrament. In that setting, I do not have the pressure of a line of people waiting to come into the Reconciliation Room. Please do not hesitate to call and make an appointment so we can take more time to fully celebrate this beautiful sacrament.

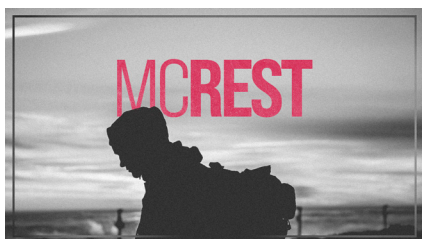

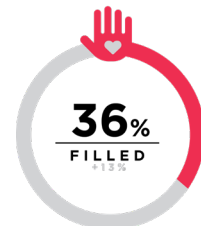

► Most Holy Trinity

This weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. The Holy Trinity, as Catholics, is our central tenant of our faith life. It is called the mystery of the faith because we are not able to grasp it with just our reason alone, it needs to be revealed to us by God.

Our Lord has done this through revelation by his actions written in scripture, by sending his only Son, and the Holy Spirit proceeding from the Father and Son at Pentecost. What was revealed is that the Holy Trinity is one God not three Gods. One God in three persons. The persons are distinct from one another which comes from their relationships. The language from our Catechism says, "It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceed."

(CCC, 81) They are one nature, wholly God. So, there is never any division, confusion, or mixing in their distinction. All salvation work that we see throughout scripture is from one God.

We see the richness of this mystery every time we begin prayer, In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Our prayers are to the Father but also through the Son and in the Holy Spirit. We never say in the names of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Our worship at Mass begins with three persons, the Trinity who is God.

That is why it is so critical when new members of the Church are baptized in the name of the Father, and of the

Son and of the Holy Spirit, and not we baptize you! Our very beginning in faith starts with the Holy Trinity, our very existence, our creation, our



life on Earth, and our eternal life with God flows from this central dogma of faith. This is why this weekend is so special for us.

► New Altar Furnishings - "From Foundation to Future"

As you may have heard, on Saturday, June 15, 2024, Archbishop Allen Vigneron will preside at our 4:30 Mass to Dedicate and Bless our new furnishings here at St. Isidore.

Life-long parishioner, Nancy Campbell was very active in parish life here at St. Isidore, devoting herself in service as a member of the Altar Society, as well as other ministries in our community. During the renovation of St. Isidore Church in the early 2000's, it was

determined that the purchase of new altar furnishings would not be possible until a much later time when all bills for the renovation were paid. Although Nancy was able to see the completion of the renovation, sadly, she passed away in July 2018 from a long-term illness. Although Nancy is no longer here with us today, her dedication and love for our church endures. Nancy willed a significant sum of money to St. Isidore for the specific purpose of

purchasing new altar furnishings for our parish community. Nancy's dream will soon be fully realized as our new furnishings are scheduled to be installed in the sanctuary the week of June 9, 2024 and blessed at the 4:30 Mass on June 15. If you are planning on attending the 4:30 Mass of Dedication, please note that with the numerous added rituals, rites, songs, and prayers, this Mass will be 90+ minutes long.

Did You Know? First Fridays Devotion

At the end of the 17th century Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and asked her to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. He made 12 promises that those who practiced the Nine First Fridays and have a deep devotion to His Sacred Heart would be blessed with. First Friday requirements: Attend Holy Mass, Receive Communion, Go to Confession within eight days before or after. You should have the intention of making reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for all the sinfulness and ingratitude of men.

Jesus made 12 promises that includes many graces, blessings, comfort, and mercy. Jesus said that those who promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out. His 12th promise is this: I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant all those who communicate on the First Friday on nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

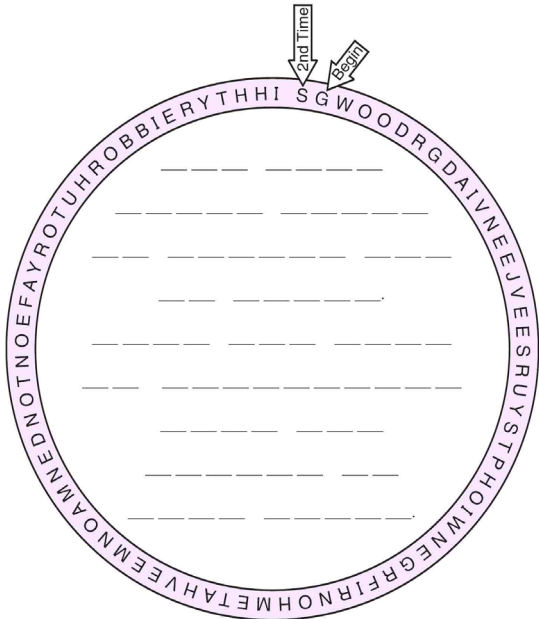

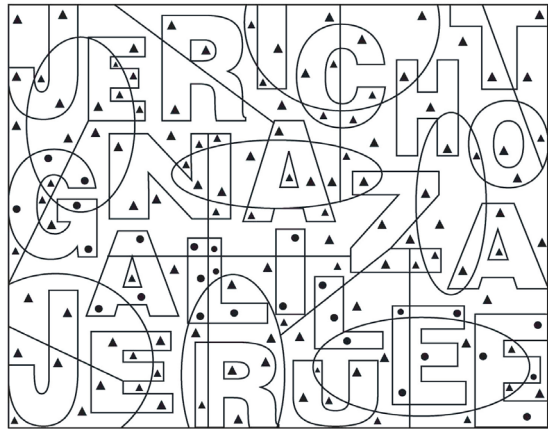

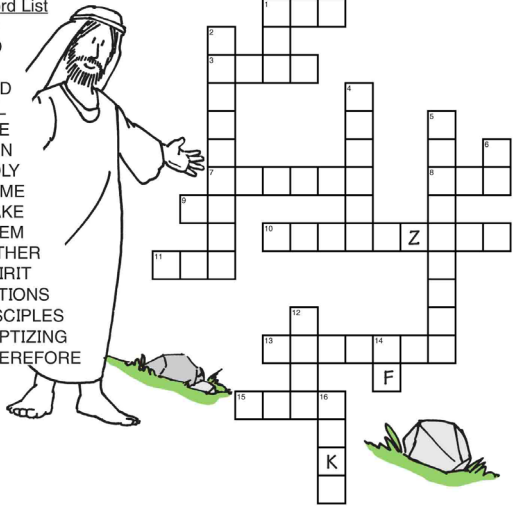
