► Introduction of the Social Justice Committee

Mission Statement: “We aim to inspire, educate and make the world a more just place.”

In the Eucharistic Prayer, “Jesus, who went about doing good” we occasionally use at Mass, we pray “the church may be living witness... peace and justice, that all people may be raised up to a new hope.” Just how can we at St. Isidore be such a witness? In upcoming articles in the Harvest News our Social Justice Committee, which has been studying the Church’s social teaching, will be sharing with you, ways we can be that witness.

Have you wondered how

you could better serve God? People are busy with work, their families and sometimes finding time is extremely hard. Did you know that you can do this daily by doing things that would not take much time but would serve God and help your neighbor? How does it sound if you did not have to attend a meeting, a class, etc. to learn more about serving God in a way that only you can do? In Pope Francis’ pastoral letters “Laudato Si” (On Care for Our Common Home) and “Laudato Deum” (Praise God), Pope Francis shares how “Care for Creation” is at the center of the Church’s Social Teachings and Respect for Life. These letters

from the Pope were written for the world!

In the future the committee will tell you about a specific issue and how you can help do your part to serve God by implementing minor changes in your life, the lives of your family or business. There will also be activities if you wish to attend, and a reward board that will be presented soon.

The committee welcomes all ideas, suggestions and new members.

Gospel, the disciples are envious and crave power. Jesus cautions them to be humble, like children.

We need to work hard, lest our passions take us too far away from God and his wisdom. We must crave the “things from above,” which, as St. James writes, are “first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good

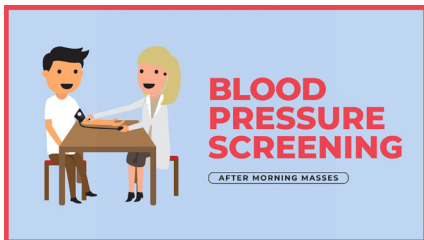
fruits, without a trace of hypocrisy or partiality.” All of these lead to peace rather than war and conflict. It is God’s will that we live in peace. Who doesn’t want to do that?

Each of us must find ways to do this. It may be helpful to pray for the needs of others rather than selfishly asking for our own, get involved in peace-making and social justice

ministries, find our identity in being close to God—not our possessions, handle disputes with mercy and love, and look up to people who have Godly wisdom rather than the rich and famous.

The Crave—for the things from above—should be a Powerful Thing!

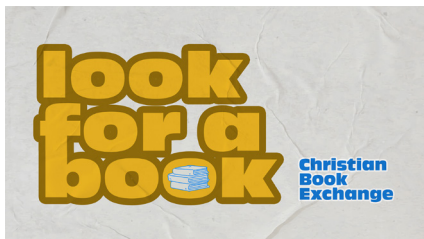

- Clothes pins (packages of 50)
- Cotton rags (new)
- Microfiber rags (new)
- Sponges with a scrub side
- Scrub brush
- Handi-wipes/reusable cloths
- Home Depot 5-gallon bucket with lid

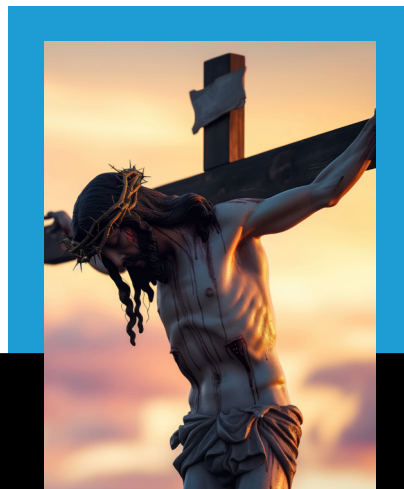
This Week's Intention: Recognizing Opportunities

all that is not ours. This is the way our patiences come, in serried ranks or in single file, and they always forget to remind us of the fact that they are the martyrdom which we were preparing. And scornfully we let them pass by, as we wait for a cause that would be worth dying for. If every redemption is a martyrdom, not every martyrdom involves the spilling of blood. From the beginning of our lives to the very end, one by one, grapes may be picked from the branch. This is the passion of patiences.
