Going into my junior year of college, I was performing in Los Angeles during the summer with a show group and was invited by an agent to relocate there and become a studio vocalist. A tempting invitation to any collegiate vocal music major, my fellow ensemble members were amazed that I did not immediately agree to this opportunity. I was

Never will anyone who says the Rosary every day be led astray. This is a statement that I would gladly sign with my blood.

In order to pray well, it is not enough to give expression to our petitions by means of that

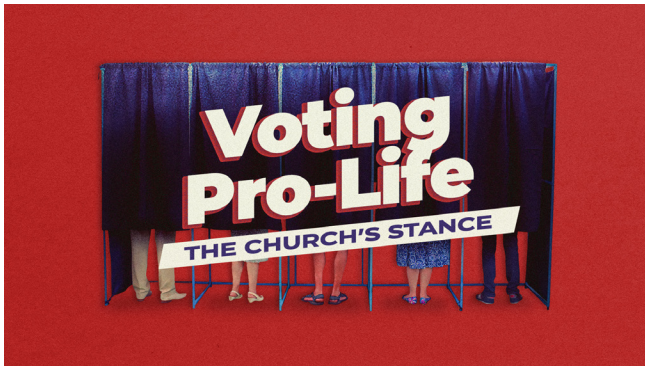
most excellent of all prayers, the Rosary, but we must also pray with real concentration for God listens more to the voice of the heart than that of the mouth.

Finally, when people say the Rosary together it is far more formidable to the devil than one said privately, because in this public prayer it is an army that is attacking him. 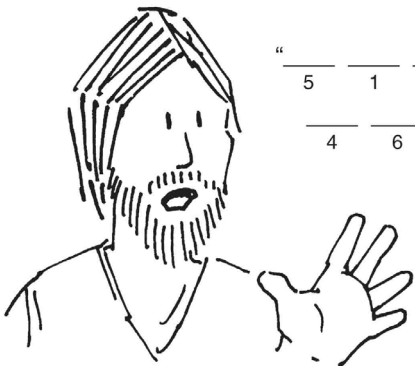

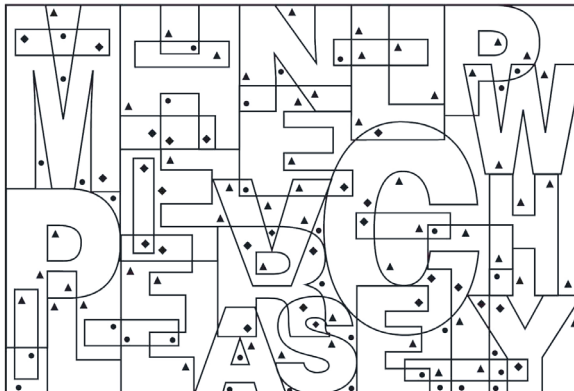

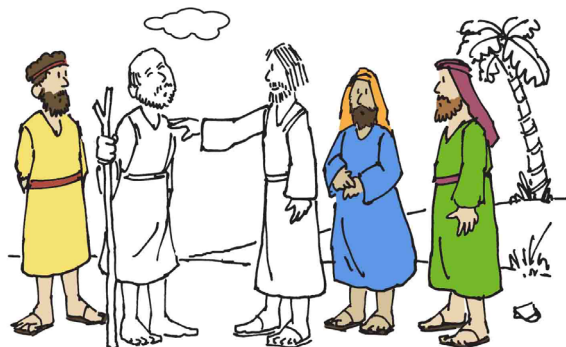
