This is a very relevant question for the last week of Advent, which will usher in the incredible feast of Christmas. This Church season calls us to find ways to make the hectic holy because we know the hectic ain't goin' away—even after Christmas is celebrated! So, let us give some serious thought as to how we can continue worshipping our loving God beyond church services.

We Catholics have many rituals and rich symbols that support us on our life journeys and draw us into the heart of God. The Mass is at the center of our worship, during which we receive the Eucharist, the source and summit of our Christian lives.

At the end of every Mass, the congregation is sent forth with the command to “Go and announce the

Gospel of the Lord” or “Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life.” This is how we can worship fully in the world. It sounds simple, but that does not mean it is easy. Each one of us goes out into “our world” with our personality, gifts, and talents to share the Good News with others and all of creation.

As we complete our Advent time of patiently waiting for Christmas, let us keep in mind that Christmas is not a day... **it is a Season!** This year Christmas is eighteen days long. It begins at 4:00 PM on Christmas Eve and continues until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 12! It includes such bright celebrations as the Feasts of The Holy Family; Mary, the Mother of God; the Epiphany (liturgically the brightest feast of the season, outshining Christmas Day itself); and the Baptism of the Lord. Let us make it truly joyful by celebrating it in its entirety! That is why it is good to celebrate Advent during Advent, and wait until Christmas to celebrate Christmas. It is difficult to enter into the many joyful Christmas feasts if we are all "Christmassed out" too early.

We thank everyone who so generously supported our Advent Giving Tree and other outreach ministries this

year. Part of our Advent Conspiracy was an attempt to "Spend Less" on ourselves and even loved ones, and to "Give More" to those in need.

Speaking of those in need, our twice-monthly distribution of food from Forgotten Harvest continues to grow. The last distribution fed 397 families. This is all possible because of the amazing team of parishioners who brave heat, rain, snow, and freezing weather to assist in the distribution. They are a brave and sturdy group. And somewhat old, as many of them are senior citizens. We thank them for their ministry. One thing that made St. Isidore the Farmer a saint was his ability to feed the hungry, even though he and his wife Maria were themselves rather poor. Feeding the hungry is one way to honor him and to live out our charism as a parish under his patronage.

## ► Ways We Can Help the Environment

Reduce your carbon "footprint." Our lakes and oceans are on the front line of climate change, absorbing about half of the carbon dioxide we've pumped into the atmosphere. Some ways we can help to stop carbon dioxide is to use mass transit and carpooling. Combine more trips at one time instead of several trips on different days, map out the stops you need to make for a more convenient route. This will also save on gas!

Another way to remove our "footprint," is not to use chemical fertilizers and pesticides on lawns and bushes. When your driveway, porches, or sidewalks need cleaning, don't use harmful cleaning products. (Dawn dish soap cleans a lot of

things.) Please take care of spilled oil and other chemicals are some examples.

Urge your friends, family, business owners, and elected representatives to support environmental policies. Policies which can protect our environment. Stay informed on alerts, like when NOT to gas your car when the weather is super-hot. Another way to share your passion is on Facebook and other media sites. There are many recycling drop-off locations throughout Michigan. Please visit the "Michigan Recycling Directory." Enter in the type of material you are looking to recycle into the search bar to find a location near you.

Some communities often host collection events for tires, electronics, batteries, paint, cleaning products, paper shredding, and more. To find one near you, search the internet and type in "Michigan.gov/recycling Directory."

unique person, but I would like to suggest that awareness of God's presence when we go out the church doors is a good practice. It takes discipline and creativity. The familiar words attributed to St. Francis of Assisi come to mind: "Preach the Gospel and, when necessary, use words." That means we can preach the Gospel by praying for others. For instance, when at a red light, perhaps you could whisper a prayer for all the motorists around you, asking God that they have a blessed day. How about adopting the attitude of gratitude? When walking down the street, notice the trees and birds and thank God for all of creation. Keep trying to hone your awareness of God as continual worship.

Another suggestion is to give God glory by your example. A smile, kind word, or kind deed is a good way to practice God's presence and remind others that God cares for them. Thus, with practice and creativity, you may notice that you are responding to God's love with all of your heart, soul, mind, and strength. Is that not worshiping fully?

The Gospel for the fourth Sunday of Advent this year begins with Mary leaving home to help her cousin, Elizabeth: "Mary set out in haste to the hill country..." Each time we leave God's house to enter the temple of God's world, let us imitate Mary, going "in haste" to do so.

During this Advent, let us ask Mary, who brought Jesus into the world, to give us the mindfulness to carry Jesus into "our world" in ways that we cannot even ask for or imagine.

## Did You Know? Gifts of the Magi

*"On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshipped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh." Luke 2:11*

You may have heard that there is spiritual meaning behind these gifts of the magi. Gold represents Jesus' kingship, frankincense represents His Divinity, and myrrh represents his death.

St. Gregory the Great tells us that we too can be bearers of these three gifts to offer to Jesus. Our gold is Christ's wisdom in us as we walk in his ways. Frankincense is our prayer and adoration. 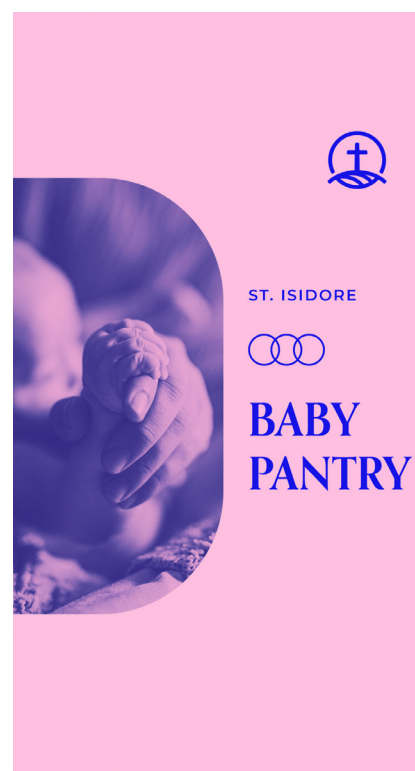
We interview every family we assist, give advice and referrals, and also provide some of the family's necessary baby items. Each family we interview increases our commitment to this vital ministry.
