When I was a teenager, I wanted to sleep in during the summer, but my parents had other ideas—chores. I often heard them say, “You’ll have plenty of time to sleep when you’re dead. Get up and get to work.” In this week’s Gospel passage, though, we hear Jesus telling us, “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.”

This selection is often used for

funerals, so in some people’s minds, rest is equated to death. We will, indeed, rest when we have gone to our eternal reward, but it is good to rest from our labors while we are still alive. I know of many people (especially men) who, after retiring, die within six months to a year because they do not know what to do for themselves; they are unable to relax.

Jesus invites us to rest and relax. While labor is useful and gives us purpose in life, it is not meant to define us. Yet, how often in gatherings does the conversation turn to queries about our occupations? As humans, we have value because of who we are—not what we do.

As children of God, we have been gifted with dignity and worth.

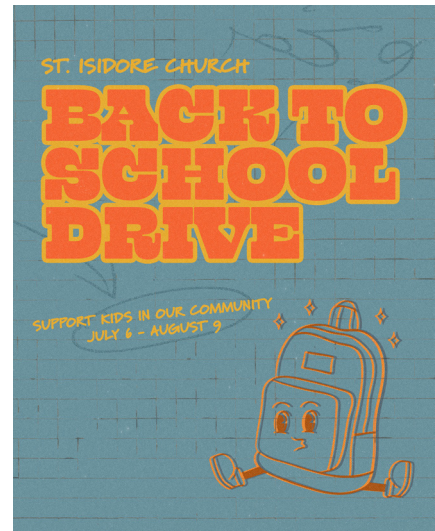

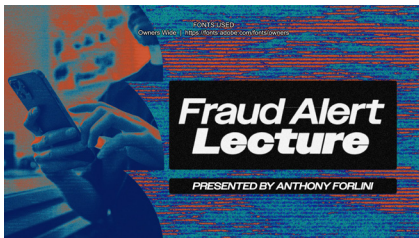

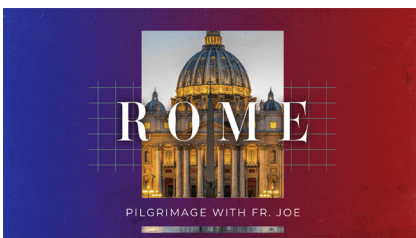

St. Isidore is blessed once again to partner with MCREST in supporting individuals and families experiencing homelessness in our community.

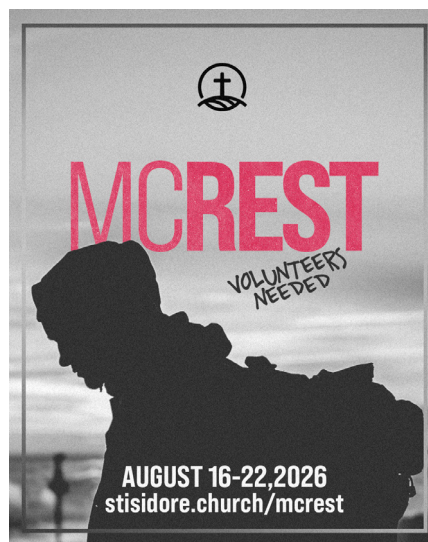
This year, rather than hosting only men at our parish, volunteers from St. Isidore will prepare and serve meals for men, women and children at the MCREST facility in Mt. Clemens throughout the week of August 16–22. This new model allows us to continue our commitment to this vital ministry while serving guests where they are currently being housed. We are also adapting our approach by opening up volunteering opportunities to individuals although opportunities for groups/ministries/organizations to take a specific day will still be available.

Volunteer opportunities will include meal preparation at our facility and transporting / serving meals at the MCREST facility. More information about specific roles and an online sign-up will be shared in the parish bulletin by mid-July.

In addition to volunteering, you can donate money through envelope and online giving as well as by dropping off essential hygiene items such as tube socks, underwear, t-shirts, travel-size toothpaste, toothbrushes, razors, alcohol-free mouthwash, shaving cream, small bars of soap, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, nail clippers, deodorant, and similar items. Bins for donated items will be located in the Gathering Space and Mary's Prayer Garden Entrance from Monday, July 13 through Friday,

August 14.

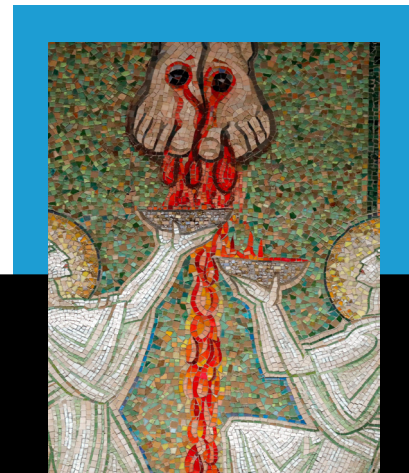

## Did You Know? The Precious Blood of Jesus

In the Catholic Church, the month of July is traditionally dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus. The devotion dates back to the early Church, but the dedication of July is closely tied to Pope Pius IX. During the First Italian War for Independence in 1849, the pope went into exile. While away, he established a universal feast for the Precious Blood to pray for peace. After the war ended, he officially declared the first Sunday in July as the Feast

of the Blood of Jesus Christ. Later, Pope Pius X set the feast day to July 1.

# Strawberry Festival

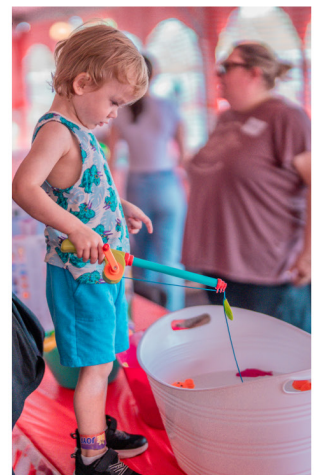
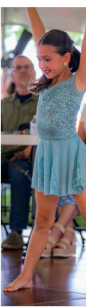
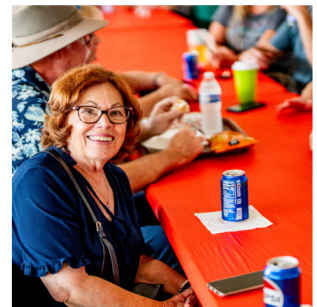

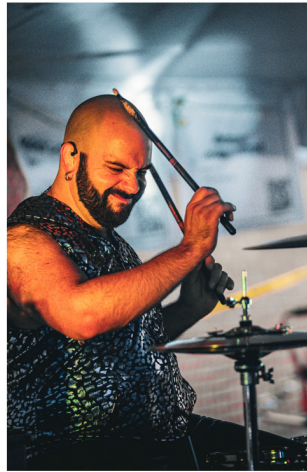
this year, the Foam Party was a huge hit and brought plenty of laughter and smiles for the younger festivalgoers.

**Sacred Seeds Answer:** Answer: Charles Carroll of Carrollton, Maryland, was the only Roman Catholic among the 56 signers of the Declaration of Independence. A few interesting facts:

- He was one of the wealthiest men in the American colonies.
- He was a cousin of John Carroll, who became the first Catholic bishop in the United States and later the first Archbishop of

Baltimore.

- Carroll was the last surviving signer of the Declaration, dying in 1832 at age 95.
